HOW TO REGISTER FOR A NEW COURSE FOR NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR


For this year we are asking all students to sign up for new courses for the next academic year, even those who currently learn with us. From next year you should be able to re-enrol with a slightly quicker process, once our system is fully up and running.

To register for a new course:

- Firstly you need to have followed the instruction about how to log into the system for the first time using the log in details sent to you. If you can't do this please email us at <u>music@coventry.gov.uk</u> and we will resend your log in details.

 - paid via school is for lessons usually primary schools where you pay for lessons directly with the school – not through us)
 - choose individual or shared lessons and lesson length (see our price list on SpeedAdmin for full price options)
 - if you are not sure which lesson to select please click unknown and leave us a message in the comment box with your requirements
- Then click the green add to my basket button
- You will then see this screen

- Or choose to "add instrument hire" (Please note if you already have an instrument on loan from us you do not need to add new hire, and you should be able to see the instrument you hire on your profile page)
- Once you are ready to complete your registration either select the "complete registration" option here or click the registration tab at the top of the screen
- To complete your registration, you need to check and complete all your details.

- You should then see a confirmation screen appear and you should receive an email confirming your registration
- You will then be on our waiting list ready for lessons in September.
- Lessons will be assigned once a tutor is confirmed and the tutor has scheduled the lessons. You will probably receive confirmation of this but can always see your scheduled lessons on the startpage or the "My Timetable" tab at the top of the page.
- If nothing appears in your calendar, then the lessons have not been scheduled yet.
- PLEASE NOTE Signing up does not guarantee you will receive lessons with us. However, please do select the course you are interested in and we will be in touch with more details as soon as we can, or alternatives should the course you have selected not be available.
