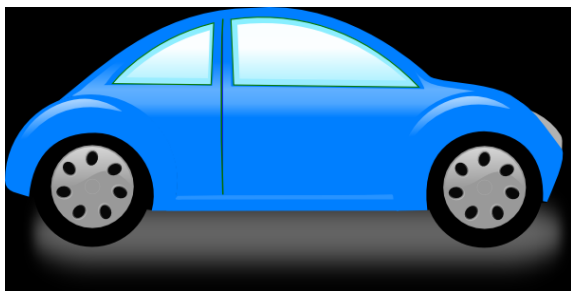

IMPROVISATION ACTIVITY

Further info about Improvisation

What is improvisation? Where musicians take a chord or scale pattern that fits within the key signature of a piece of music and they make-up a melody/tune to play along as a soloist in the band. Piano and guitar players can choose to play melodies or a sequence of chord rhythms over the backing from the rest of the band.

We played our 12 bar blues piece in the key of F so the chord pattern goes like this:

So when in the chord of F start with FAC as the notes in that chord, then maybe add some joining notes F G A Bb C etc and have a go at adding in different rhythms and jumping around the pitches.

Remember – you can't go wrong with improvisation as its your own ideas and original composition!
