

HOW TO REGISTER FOR A NEW COURSE FOR NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR

We have a new system which we are rolling out this year. Here are the instructions on how to register your interest in learning music through Coventry Music or attending one of our groups.

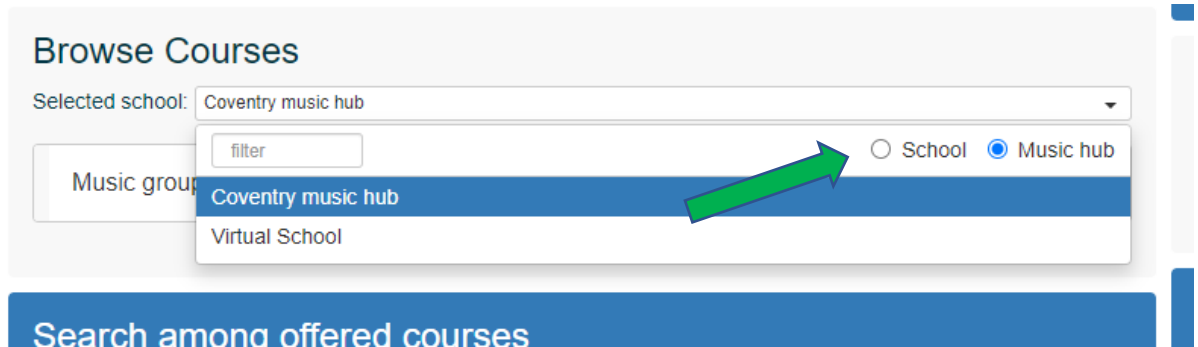
If you have already had lessons with us or attended a group, you may already have a log in with us – contact us at music@coventry.gov.uk to check and receive your log in details.

- Once you have clicked on the link above you should see the following screen

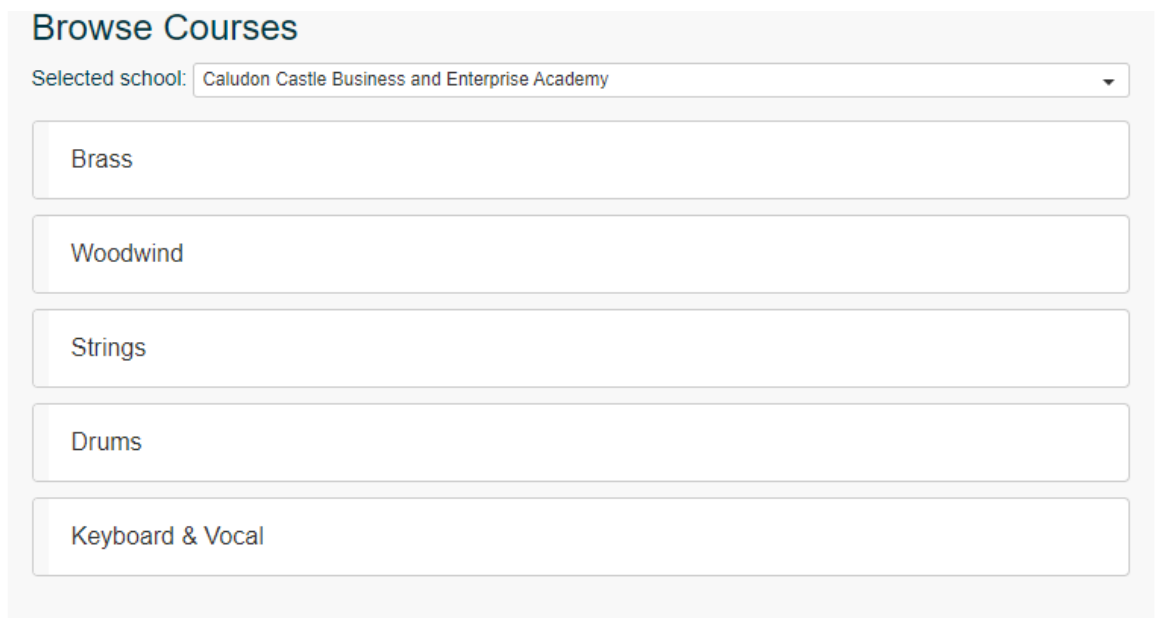

- Click the small arrow to the right of the white box named “selected school” in the browse courses grey box.

- Find your child's school and click it.
- **If you would to have lessons directly with us at our new music centre due to open Sep 2021, (usually after school hours) then please select Drapers Hall - Coventry Music Hub as the school. These places will be strictly limited.**

- Then click the green add to my basket button

- From here you can add more courses to your basket – “add more courses”

- Complete your application – “complete application”

(Please note if you already have an instrument on loan from us you do not need to add new hire, and you should be able to see the instrument you hire on your profile page)
- Once you are ready to complete your registration either select the “complete registration” option here or click the registration tab at the top of the screen
- To complete your registration, **you need to check and complete all your details.**
- Firstly you need to read and agree to our terms and conditions

 - Once you have completed a section click the green next button to move to the next section
 - In the parent/carer section you also have the option to add another parent if you would like any information/contact to be sent to an additional person. This will link up with your account.
- Once you have answered the additional questions in the questions section you can click on the green submit button.

- You should then see a confirmation screen appear and you should receive an email confirming your registration
- You will then be on our waiting list ready for lessons in September.
- Lessons will be assigned once a tutor is confirmed and the tutor has scheduled the lessons. You will should receive a confirmation of this and can always see your scheduled lessons/registrations on the startpage or the “My Timetable” tab at the top of the page.
- If nothing appears in your calendar ad you are still appearing on the waiting list, then the lessons have not been scheduled yet.
- **PLEASE NOTE Signing up does not guarantee you will receive lessons with us. However, please do select the course you are interested in and we will be in touch with more details as soon as we can, or alternatives should the course you have selected not be available.**

HOW TO REGISTER ON ENSEMBLE GROUP

- If you wish to register for an ensemble music group, follow the same process as above, except do not select a school but select music hub and then Coventry Music Hub
